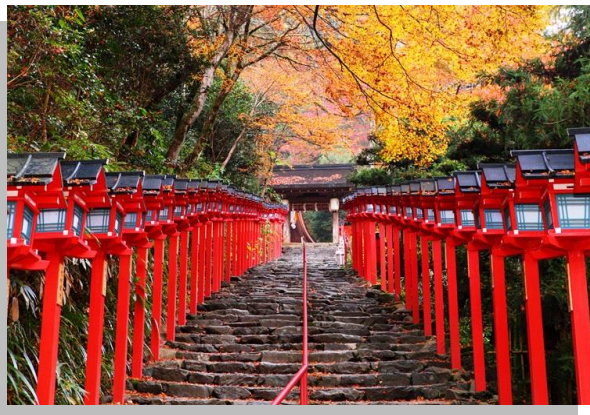
Our school is a five-minute walk from Kyoto Station. Within walking distance of the school, you'll find a great many locations that blend elements of history, culture, and nature.

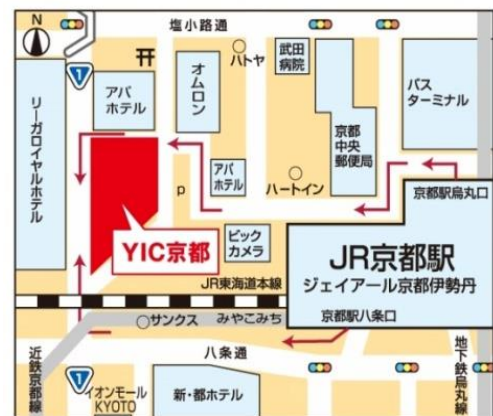
